

Fremont Area Community Foundation Match Day



Match your dollars with Foundation Funds to support your favorite local nonprofits!

When: Thursday, September 17, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

The Fremont Area Community Foundation (FACF), with its Fund partners, is offering \$150,000 (and growing) in “match” money. Individual community donors, giving generously to their favorite qualifying Newaygo County organizations, will have their donations matched by the Foundation’s Funds. Join the Foundation and your favorite nonprofits for a day of festive activities and philanthropy.

Match Day Details and Guidelines (go to www.tfacf.org for up-to-date information)

Donations by cash, check, or credit card shall be presented to the office of the Community Foundation at 4424 W. 48th Street, Fremont (across the street from Newaygo Medical Care Facility) on Match Day. We are unable to accept donations for Match Day online, by phone, or by mail.

1. Donations will be matched \$1 for \$1, up to \$5,000 per donor household up to the match amount (currently \$150,000).
2. A single nonprofit may receive up to 20% of the total match dollars, and, a separate \$1,000 prize will be awarded to the nonprofit that receives the greatest number of donations.
3. Checks should be made payable to FACF or Fremont Area Community Foundation with the name of the qualifying nonprofit in the memo line of the check.
4. Qualifying non-profit organizations are those with an endowment fund at FACF and listed on the Match Day Qualifying Organizations List. You will find the list of qualifying organizations on our website at www.tfacf.org. In recognition of these tough economic times the donations and match will be used by these organizations to support their mission of assisting others in Newaygo County.
5. For donations to multiple nonprofits, a form is available to accompany your donation which lists the eligible organizations and an amount you would like to designate for each. The form is available on the www.tfacf.org website, and at the FACF office.
6. All donations and match dollars will be granted from the Community Foundation directly to the qualifying nonprofit. No fees will be deducted by the Foundation. Nonprofits will be given their “Match Day” checks on October 16, 2009. Stay tuned for event details...

Match Day Frequently Asked Questions



What is Match Day?

A one-day only event in which anyone can make a donation to a qualifying Newaygo County nonprofit organization and receive a match to the same organization.

When is Match Day?

Thursday, September 17, 2009, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

How & Where do I donate?

Bring your cash, check, or credit card (Visa/MC) to the Fremont Area Community Foundation's office at 4424 W. 48th Street, Fremont (across from the Newaygo Medical Care Facility). Then, mingle with your favorite nonprofits while enjoying music, food and drink.

Why should I participate?

Match Day provides the opportunity to multiply support to your favorite local nonprofits by matching your donation with Foundation Funds. All donations collected on Match Day will be granted by the Foundation to the designated nonprofits, at no cost to you or the nonprofits.

Which nonprofit organizations qualify for match dollars?

A qualifying organization is any Newaygo County nonprofit organization that has a Fund with the Community Foundation and is listed on Match Day Qualifying Organizations at www.tfacf.org. Your gift and the Foundation match are designed to support the non-profits' charitable missions in Newaygo County and will be granted directly to the non-profit organizations.

Is there a minimum or maximum donation amount?

No. All donation amounts will be accepted. All gifts up to \$5,000 per donor household may be matched. No single non-profit organization will receive more than 20% of the total Foundation match.

Can I mail in my donation?

In order to qualify for match dollars, donations must be made in person at the Foundation office. If you can't join us in person, you can give your pre-dated (September 17) check to a friend or family member and they can deliver the check to us on Match Day.

Can I make my donation online?

In order to qualify for match dollars donations must be made in person at the Foundation office. You may still donate by credit card at the event.

What if I want to contribute but cannot get to the Foundation on September 17?

You can give your check to a friend or family member and ask them to bring it in on your behalf – you might even encourage them to write a check of their own!

To whom should my check be made payable?

FACF or Fremont Area Community Foundation. In the memo line on your check, please indicate the organization to which you are donating.

Can I make a donation to more than one organization?

Yes! Please use the **Match Day Qualifying Organization List** to indicate which organizations you are supporting and how much you wish to donate to each organization.

When will the organizations receive the money collected on Match Day?

October 16, 2009.
